

Basic Dog Obedience Class

Dear Pet Owner,

Paws Along the River Humane Society is excited to present a basic dog obedience training class. The **first class** will be for an orientation with pet owners only. **DO NOT BRING YOUR DOGS** to this first Orientation evening! The time will be 7:00 P.M.

The Humane Society Educational Room at 212 Elm Street will be the setting for the Dog Obedience. The cost of the 8 week program will be \$90.00. The class size will be limited to 8 dogs. Space inside is limited to 2 people maximum per family.

The regular class time for the balance of 7 lessons, with dogs present, will be at 6:00 p.m.

We ask that dog owners wear comfortable clothes and closed toe shoes, no sandals or flip flops. Training your dog can be strenuous and you need to have appropriate foot wear for your safety and the safety of others in class.

All dogs enrolled in class must be current on vaccinations:

- **Rabies**
- **Bordetella**
- **Distemper**

A copy of your dog's vaccines must be included with your registration.

To comply with our insurance regulations for these classes any dog handler under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult and no children under 13 years of age will be accepted as the dog's handler/trainer in class. We do encourage the children to participate at home in the dog's training and learning adventures. Training and enjoying your dog should be a total family experience!

Our instructor Donna Anderson (see biography) will give you more information at orientation. Remember, this first evening is an orientation class **for owners only**. To reserve a place for your dog in this session, please complete and return

- **Full payment**

All class registration forms and payment must be received the day before orientation class to guarantee a place in class!
